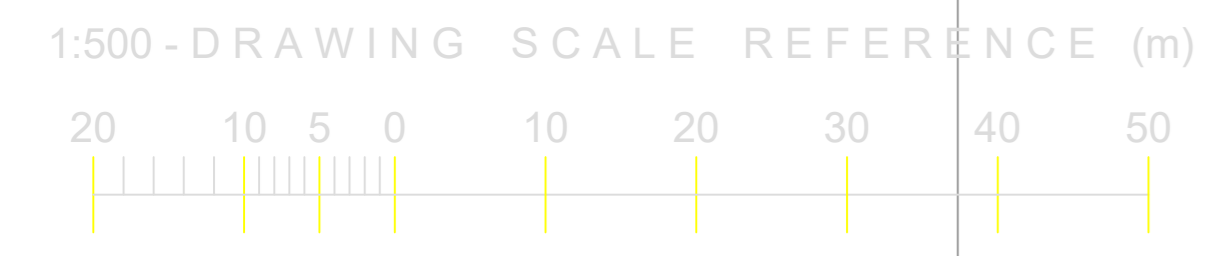
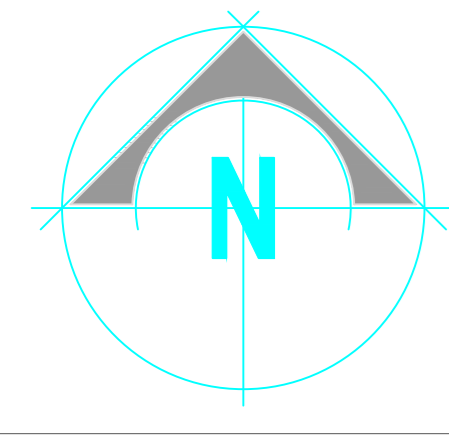

Landscape Statement:
The proposals include new community facilities set within the existing setting of paddocks, woodland and mature hedgerows. All significant vegetation will be retained (see Arboicultural Survey report).

Landscape proposals include extensive new sections of mixed native tree and hedgerow planting. Ongoing management will be coordinated by Poringland Parish Council, and it is planned will mainly be undertaken by community volunteers.

A Management Plan sets out goals for habitat and biodiversity enhancement as well as other requirements for successful management of a public open space.

Likely tree species might include: Acer, Alnus, Betula, Corylus, Malus, Pinus, Prunus, Pyrus, Quercus, Sorbus, and Tilia.

Likely groundcover in the car park might include Dryingopteris, Iris, Lamium, Pulmonaria, Salvia, Symphytum and native bulb planting.

Mixed native hedging - Acer, Carpinus, Crataegus, Cornus, Corylus, Ilex, Malus, Prunus, Rhamnus, Viburnum etc will be used to enhance boundary hedges.
