The Clerk role is key to enabling the Parish Council to provide an efficient and well managed service to the community. During her time with us, Catherine was responsible for the delivery of a wide range of projects and initiatives within the Parish, including bringing 'The Vision' to a reality with the Community Land Project, introducing the Neighbourhood Plan and generally transforming the Parish Council into a more modern and interactive body. Her knowledge of the workings of Parish Councils has proved invaluable to both Councillors and community alike and we are sad to see her go. We would like to wish Catherine every success with her new role and for the future.

This is also the perfect opportunity to introduce our new Parish Clerk - Faye LeBon. Faye will be joining us in January from her current role as Clerk to Swanton Morley. Faye brings with her a wealth of experience, particularly in neighbourhood planning. We look forward to welcoming her to the Poringland Parish. We would also like to extend our thanks and appreciation to Rachel McCarthy and the team (Lisa, Sara and Stephanie) for holding the fort whilst recruitment of the new Clerk has been underway.

### **Community Land Project**

The Community Land project is, at its name suggests, a 14 acre site behind The Ridings that has been earmarked to deliver a range of facilities to the community, including allotments, a running track, a 'Men's Shed' area and a village green. September saw Council representives meet with the appointed architect, and plans to make the vision into a reality are progressing through the transfer of the land from Norfolk Homes.

# **Neighbourhood Planning Update**

An important milestone was reached in September on the journey to the adoption of a Neighbourhood Plan for Poringland.

Two public consultation events were held to share the first draft of the policies that will eventually make up the Plan. Over 200 people came along to see the displays, ask questions and give their feedback, which was very positive overall. This has all been collated and was shared with the Neighbourhood Plan Committee at their October meeting. Each policy is now being reviewed in light of the feedback and the draft Plan will be ready to view in the New Year – copies can be sent out upon request, or collected from the council office.
