Parish Council Report

The last three months seem to have been a time for pressing ahead with exciting projects and developments for the village. The Community Land Project (development of the land behind The Ridings) is moving forward well, with the Council appointing a lead consultant to take us through the planning permission stages. We are currently transferring the legal ownership of the land from Norfolk Homes to the Parish Council, and we are incredibly grateful to Norfolk Homes for their kindness and generosity in gifting this land to the parish, together with a package of support to get this recreational site off to a flying start.

We ended the year financially in a good position, and in the next few weeks more detail on this will land on your doorstep in the shape of the Annual Report. While the surpluses of the last couple of years could not be seen this year, we did end the year with broadly the same free funds in the Council's accounts, and the ability to deliver costly projects such as the Community Land Project, Neighbourhood Planning, and a much-needed extension to the Community Centre car park. This year we plan to decorate the Community Centre, and to upgrade the heating system in the Playing Field Pavilion, which will connect to the Football Club's project to move the showers to the far end of the building. This coupled with no increase in the Parish Council's share of the council tax, means that the Council is in a strong position to continue to improve services within the village.

Finally, in March we were sad to say goodbye to Jenny Kereama-Ellis, who had been a councillor for over 17 years. Jenny's commitment, enthusiasm and style ideas have helped develop the Community Centre into the thriving facility it now is. Jenny decided that the time was right for her to retire from the Council, and in her place in April we were pleased to welcome John Joyce, who has already been spending some time with us on the Neighbourhood Plan Committee. Welcome to the Council, John!
