Parish Council Report

Christmas Event: Christmas may be all of a distant memory now, however as this is our first newsletter of the New Year, we would like to place on record our thanks to everyone who supported our Christmas event at the community centre. We were humbled by how many people who came to watch the tree lights switched on, see Santa Claus, sing some carols and partake in a mince pie. David Wilson Homes and South Norfolk Council provided financial support to enable the event to go ahead, and Ben Burgess loaned us specialist equipment, provided man-power and gave us the Christmas Tree stand (all of which were significant contributions given the size of the tree)! We were thrilled with the other community groups that got involved, such as the church and the Can't Sing Won't Sing group. Thank you to everyone who provided feedback, which has encouraged us to run another event in 2020. We have pencilled in the date of Sunday 6th December – so watch this space!

Increased Recycling Facilities: The Parish Council is partnering with Terracycle to provide recycling facilities above and beyond what can be recycled via the green wheelie bins. We are now able to collect baby food pouches and plastic can holders. Please feel free to drop these off at the community centre so we can recycle them.

Reducing Environmental Impact: The community centre is in the process of changing its consumable products to those which hold the EU Ecolabel award. This is awarded to products meeting high environmental standards throughout their life-cycle, from raw material extraction, to production, distribution and disposal. The Parish Council will continue to review its services and consider environmental impact when decisions are made.

Please be Courteous: The council is in receipt of increased complaints about parking on pavements. As a driver this may be convenient, but it leaves pedestrians, particularly vulnerable residents such as those with physical disabilities and those with children, having to walk in the road to get round your car. Please think when you park!

Parish Precept

At the meeting on 8th January, the Parish Council agreed the 2020/2021 parish precept. This is the part of the council tax which is apportioned directly to Poringland. As a rapidly growing village, we have taken the decision to increase the amount payable by 4.29%. In financial terms, those living in a Band D property will pay an extra £3.68 per year (approximately 30p per month) to support the services provided by the Parish Council. Those living in properties which are classified as A-C will pay less than this.

Playing Field

The Parish Council has instructed works to commence on improving the drainage to the entrance to the park at the playing field. In addition to this, we would like to thank Framingham Earl Parish Council for their financial donation towards the maintenance of the playing field.
